

Remote Teaching and Learning – 15th – 17th February

Dear Parents,

In response to the circuit breaker lockdown and current Stage 4 restrictions, Western Autistic School has moved to a remote teaching and learning model.

Your class teacher will be in daily contact today with you to discuss your child's learning, and ways in which we can partner with you to develop learning opportunities for your child in your home context.

Teachers will focus on:

- Working with you to help students understand the change to their normal routine
- Supports for providing structure to the day at home aligned with simple school routines
- Ways to build communication opportunities naturally within the student's home environment

Teachers will also work with you to arrange SSG meetings on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. During these meetings teachers will work with you to identify priorities for your child's learning for inclusion on their Individual Learning Plan. They will also be an opportunity to talk about your child's transition pathway beyond the school, and any other priorities you may have for discussion.
